NEW YEAR CELEBRATIONS AT ÇAĞ COLLEGE

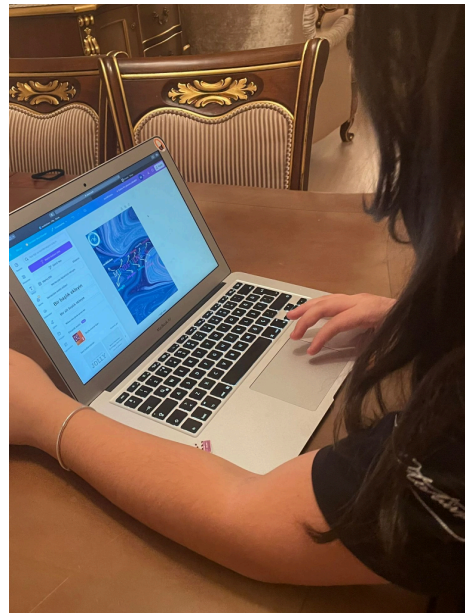
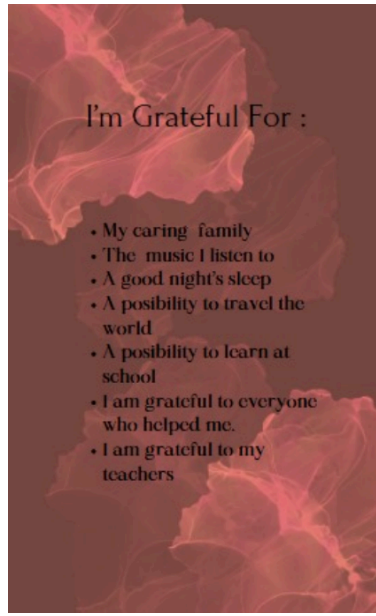
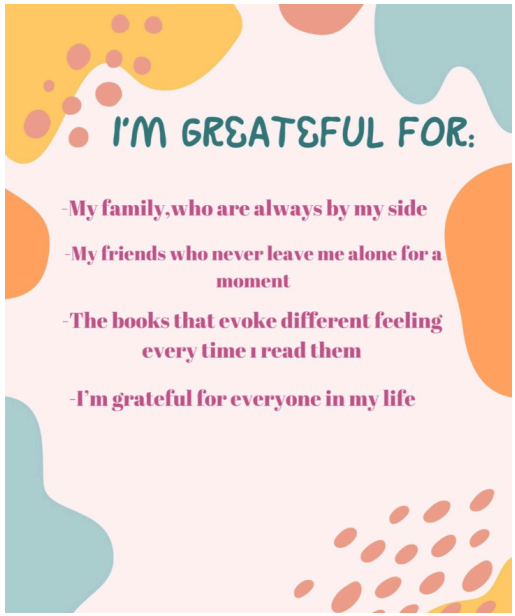

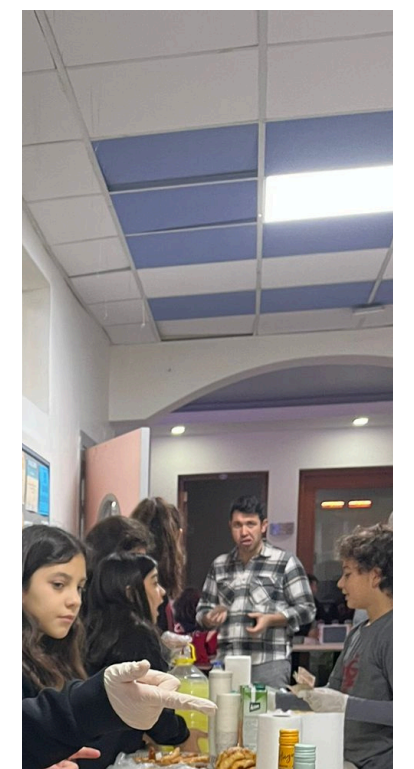
TIPS FOR STAYING SAFE IN THE DIGITAL WORLD
