On February 14, 2025, Çağ College High School students from grades 9, 10, and 11 took the Hippo English Quarter Final Exam.The Hippo exam, conducted in over 50 countries with support from GateHouse Awards and Mizzou International, promotes cultural exchange through English. It consists of three stages: Quarter Final, Semi-Final, and Final. While Quarter Finals are held in schools, Semi-Finals take place at designated centers. Finalists compete in Venice, with expenses covered except for travel.Successful students receive internationally recognized GateHouse Awards certificates. At Çağ College, language proficiency is assessed by the Foreign Language Education Coordinatorship, and students engage in Interactive English activities throughout the year.
